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**“Diamonds are a couples best friend”**

Nationally recognised Master Goldsmith Trevor Towner, from Petersfield, Hampshire, has crafted yet another simplistic and collectible precious thimble to celebrate the Royal sixtieth wedding anniversary this November.

Celebrating the Diamond wedding anniversary of her Majesty the Queen and His Royal Highness the Prince Phillip on November 20<sup>th</sup>, Trevor has designed another limited edition silver and a silver gilt thimble.

After the recent success of The Queen's 80<sup>th</sup> Birthday and Golden Jubilee thimbles, both of which were presented to her majesty, this 25mm high silver / silver gilt thimble has an applied pair of rhodium plated silver wedding bells, beautifully set with a single brilliant cut diamond within a relief bow design.

The left hand bell is engraved E II R, whilst the other has PP – for Prince Phillip; the date 1947 – 2007 is hand engraved underneath.

The reverse of the thimble is stamped with Trevor's sponsors mark the infamous TT and all other required hallmarks of quality for precious metals. Also, the limited edition number will be placed here 1 – 100. The 60<sup>th</sup> one is already reserved for HM The Queen.

This thimble is another in a unique collection started by Trevor in 1997, and is available by personal order from the Trevor Towner Showroom in Petersfield's High Street.

Customers have maintained their personal collections in many ways, some having had bespoke display cabinets and shelves made for them to appreciate daily in their own unique way.

Trevor Towner first opened a combined workshop and showroom in Petersfield in 1983. In 1989 he was elected a Fellow of the Institute of Professional Goldsmiths.

Whilst working in the creative studios of Stuart Devlin, London; Trevor specialised in the creation and production of fine pieces of silver jewellery for various Heads of State and again our own Royal Family, Trevor became a “Master Craftsman” and was awarded the Freedom of the Worshipful company of Goldsmiths and the Freedom of the City of London.
